Bus Shelter Policy

The Bus Shelter Policy was adopted by Full Council at its Meeting held on 6 March 2018.

Brick built Bus shelters are located along local public bus routes as these reflect the demand for the bus service. Currently there are 6 Bus Shelter, 3 at Hazlemere Crossroads, I at Cozy Corner, 2 in Rose Avenue. Advertising is permitted at the 3 bus shelters at Hazlemere Crossroads by Out and About Advertising.

The responsibility for the maintenance and cleanliness of a bus shelter falls with the Parish Council and the proper maintenance of the bus shelters is crucial and requires those damaged to be repaired quickly and to a high standard; any graffiti is removed/painted over as soon as possible. The annual maintenance budget is £500. The bus shelters are cleaned as needed.

All Bus Shelters are designed as Smoke Free Public Areas in accordance with the Health Act 2006 Chapter 28 Part 1 Smoking. The appropriate no smoking signs will be displayed.(need to be arranged)

To request a new bus shelter

At Hazlemere Parish Council, the Council is committed to providing improved waiting facilities. Any requests for a bus shelter need to be channeled through the Parish Council as they will need to ensure there is local support for the proposal and relevant permissions will need to be obtained.

Advertising on bus shelters

Any advertising on Council property may only be displayed with written authority from Hazlemere Parish Council.
