

Hazlemere Parish Council Donate a Bench Scheme

The Donate a Bench Policy was adopted by Full Council at its Meeting held on 3 March 2019.

Introduction:

The Parish Council receives many requests for memorials and donations to create a focus for a memory of something or someone. Many of these requests are because a family member wishes to remember someone with a memorial or commemorate a birth, or a wedding.

Making a donation is a positive way of commemorating these events, and it helps the Council manage a special place for the benefit of all. Memorial and donation options include, seating, picnic tables, spring bulbs and interpretation signage.

The information below will help to answer any questions you have about how to proceed with your donation idea.

Procedure:

- **Initial Contact:** The initial point of contact for any enquiry relating to a donation request is The Clerk, Hazlemere Parish Council, Barn Lane, Hazlemere HP15 7BQ 01494 715548 hazlemere.parish@btconnect.com
- **Submission of forms:** Applicant to complete a submission of interest form with details about the request, location etc.
- **Approval:** The application will be assessed to determine the appropriateness of the request by the Full Council. If successful, a final cost will be provided with an expected time frame for delivery.
- **Enquirer:** To agree to terms and conditions, sign contract and provide cheque for agreed amount.
- **Completion:** The enquirer will be contacted prior to installation where possible and when the installation is complete a photograph will be taken for records and a copy sent to the enquirer.

Guiding Principles of donations:

- To be respectful, sympathetic and easily understood by the public
- To balance the sometimes contrasting needs of a variety of site users
- To maintain and enhance the high quality appearance of sites and not detract from their prime purpose.

Sites Included

The Dell Recreation Ground, Rose Avenue Recreation Ground and Hazlemere Recreation Ground and any other land owned by the Council.
